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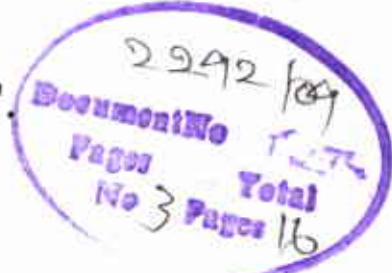

**NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS :**

The Founder of the Trust do hereby created and constitutes a Public Social Welfare Trust for the objects detailed hereunder and hereby endows a sum of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) as the initial corpus fund and the Trustees herein do hereby acknowledge the receipt of the same for the objects stated hereinafter mentioned.

**1. NAME OF THE TRUST :**

**" TEAM EVEREST "**



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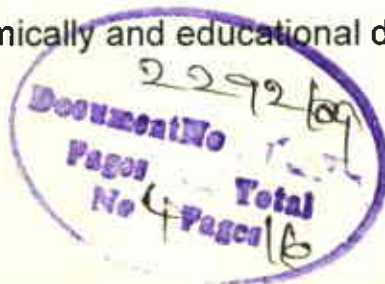
2. **OFFICE OF THE TRUST:**

The Office of the Trust shall be at **No.5/1B, Magaveerar Street, Arni Palayam, Arni-632 301, Tiruvannamalai District, (or)** Such other place as may be found suitable from time to time.

**OBJECTS OF THE TRUST:**

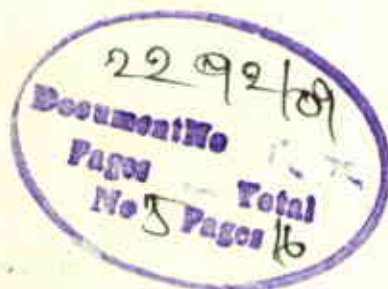
3. **TO PROVIDE SOCIAL ACTIVITIES FOR EDUCATIONAL, MEDICAL, AND SOCIAL ASSISTANCE IN ALL NEEDY PEOPLE AND RELIEF TO THE DOWN-TRODDEN, WEAKER SECTIONS, WOMEN'S, HANDICAPPED AND EX-SERVICEMEN OF THE SOCIETY:-**

1. To help the under privileged students who suffers to pay School/college fees.
2. To teach good values, ethics among students through various initiatives like magic show, puppet shows etc.
3. To motivate and inspire the Indian youths though various educational programmes.
4. To provide a medium for the exchange of information about the activities, objectives and experiences of similar organizations.
5. To conduct periodic lectures, meetings, conferences, seminars and surveys on matters of interest to the weaker sections of the people.
6. To provide children kindergarten, schools, colleges for the weaker section, urban , backward and downtrodden.
7. To promote all manners of cultural activities that will enrich the lives of the rural people.
8. To engage in kids/adult education, and non-formal education, for the development of rural people.
9. To promote the interests and all round welfare of all the socially, economically and educational down-trodden people of India.



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10. To provide relief to needy during the natural calamities. To form Women & Men Self Help groups and undertake activities for their own development and to provide sanitary facilities for women and children and promote preventive measures affecting the health of women and children in the rural areas.
11. Provide appropriate services for the socially educational and economically weaker sections of the people which will not prejudice, self-reliance to encourage the sprit of voluntarism by revitalizing the existing voluntary social welfare groups particularly local action oriented groups.
12. To provide a common forum for the voluntary agencies concerned with growth and development, to share their cherished ideas and through which to noble them to speed up the process of concerted efforts for action.
13. To promote rural youths and rural women's through village in integrated rural development.
14. To conduct health education programmes and Human rights progammes, such as providing free legal aid, Human rights awareness, free blood testing camps, Anti HIV and rehabilitation for women and juvenile including in prostitution for creating awareness programmes to widen the knowledge on medicine for the rural peoples.
15. To provide accommodation such as food, shelter, cloths for orphans, helpless children, blind, deaf and dumb.
16. To promote tailoring, embroidering and other readymade garments for rural women by providing training programmes.

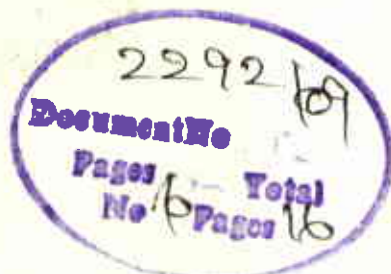


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17. To promote uplift of women by educating them on handicraft such as coir craft and other handy craft from agricultural products and other handicraft.
18. To do all such other lawful things as may be incidental to or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.
19. To study the problem of Indian as well as International Weaker Sections of the people and focus attention on them.
20. To enable the socially, educationally and economically down-trodden people of India to realize and fulfill their responsibilities in themselves, in society to the country and the world.
21. To bring together and co-ordinate the activities or and affiliate regeneration working for the welfare of the socially, educationally and economically down-trodden people.
22. To help them acquire local need based requisite minimum knowledge and skill in the field of economic activities.
23. The benefit of the services rendered by the Trust are open to all irrespective of caste, religion or sex.
24. To raise funds and to receive donations, contributions, gifts and subscriptions for carrying out the objects of the Trust.

**4. TO PROMOTE AND CARRY OUT THE OBJECTIVES:**

- a. The trust is empowered to apply for and receive grants and contributions both from individuals internal and External Agencies Institutions, State and Central Government.
- b. The trust is empowered to raise loans and such funds from financial institutions and government in future.
- c. To appoint persons representatives, agents on their works on such conditions as may be thought necessary by the trust.



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- e. The trust funds to be acquired or earned shall be solely utilized towards fulfilling of the objects and no portion of it shall be utilized for payments to trustees by way of profit interest or dividends or otherwise. The programmes and benefits shall be open to all those who need as the case may be.

**5. OBJECTS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITY:**

- a. To carry out the objects of general public utility, not involving the carrying on of any activity for profit motive such as to establish, run, maintain and develop, public halls, cyclone relief Centers, communal riot relief centers, homes for the aged, destitute men, women and children, on no loss and no profit basis.
- b. **FOOD & NUTRITION:**
- (i) To give employment to Weaker section, handicapped persons, ex-servicemen for the purpose of meeting the objects.
- (ii) To purchase or acquire by donation or reserve agricultural lands for the purpose of meeting the objects in future
- (iii) To receive and assist for food, clothes and shelter for displaced persons.
- c. To accept foreign contributions on behalf of the trust and utilize such contributions for the purpose of carrying on medical relief to the persons.
- f. To do all other lawful things as are incidents to any of the above objects and that the same shall be carried only on no loss or and no profit basis.



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6. The activities of the Trust shall be confined within India and Trust shall have no power to spend money on any of the objects outside the Indian Territory.

7. **BENEFICIARIES:**

The Beneficiaries of the Trust shall be the Weaker section, poor, both men and women, children, handicapped and any individual deserving the aid succor and upliftment without any distinction of caste, colour, creed, sex or religion.

8. **CONSTITUTIONS OF THE TRUST BOARD :**

The Trust Board shall consist of 3 persons, One Founder President, One Secretary, One Treasurer.

9. **ADMINISTRATION :**

**WHEREAS THE FOUNDER AND PRESIDENT OF THE TRUST.**

1. **Mr.C. KARTHEEBAN**, S/o.Mr.K.Chandra Mohan, aged about 24 years, residing at No.5/1B, Magaveeraa Street, Arni Palayam, Arni-632 301, Tiruvannamalai District, **AS A FOUNDER AND PRESIDENT.**
2. **Mr.M. RAJ KUMAR**, S/o.Mr.N.Mani, aged about 27 years, residing at No.13/6, Seshathri Palayam, Mettu Street, Kancheepuram-631 501, **AS A SECRETARY.**
3. **V.THILAGAVATHI**, D/o.Mr. D.Venugopal, aged about 24 years, residing at No.2/83, North Street, Perahambi Post, Trichy District-621 104, **AS A TREASURER.**

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**10. POWER OF THE PRESIDENT:**

President of the Trust shall be Executive Head of the Trust. His/her advice shall be final in all matters pertaining to the administration of the Trust. He shall preside over all meetings, conduct the meetings in a democratic manner.

President of the Trust is the head who will be the chief administrator and the President will appoint other office bearers.

**11. POWER OF THE SECRETARY:**

a) He shall:

- i) Manage all the affairs of the trust.
- ii) Convene Trusts Board Meetings.
- iii) Incur expenses accounting to the budget and produce receipt and account thereof in each Trust Board meeting.
- iv) Enter into correspondence with all parties.
- v) They shall authorize all payments to the treasurer.

b) He is empowered to be present before authorize to give written petition, to correspond to maintain registers, files etc., of the Trust to regularize the aims, plans and activities of the Trust.

c) He is also empowered to convene Trust Board meetings, to set up office, to appoint clerk, maintain registers, files, etc., of the Trust, to regularize the aims, plans and activities of the Trust.

**12. POWER OF THE TREASURER:**

He will be in charge of the accounts, and receipts for the amount in his custody, get the authorization of the Secretary for the disbursements, of money, maintain the accounts, submit the money accounts to the Secretary, and arrange for the audit of the accounts.



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**13. POWER OF THE FOUNDER:**

The Founder shall hold office at her/his pleasure and on the vacation of office, the Founder herein on his/her own volition or by death or otherwise the remaining Trustees herein shall appoint the legal heirs of the deceased. They are also entitled to enjoy all the rights enjoyed by the founder.

**14. POWER OF THE TRUSTEES:**

The Trustee shall hold the trust fund on the following terms:

The Founder & Trustees shall pass resolution by circulation in case of an urgent issue. They may make rules for regulating their meetings and the trustees may repeal later any rules made pursuant to this clause.

- a. To manage the Trust Fund and collect and recover the interest, dividends and other income there of and to pay and discharge out of the income of the trust fund all expenses and charges for collecting and recovering the income of the trust fund and all other costs. Charges and expenses and out going of and incidental to the trust created by theirs presents and the administration thereof.
- b. To apply the trust money to effectuate one objects or some of the objects of the trust in preference to other object(s). To discontinue the applications of trust funds to the objects and divert the funds to objects of the trust.
- c. To receive donations either by cash or kind of legacy or any other means from foreign countries or in India by way of corpus for on revenue account.
- d. In case it is decided to render financial or other aid to any persons or institutions within the scope of the objects, to decide the terms and conditions which shall be complied with by such persons or institutions.



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- e. To determine if necessary, the terms and conditions on which any donation, subscriptions, scholarships or prizes or medals are to be given by the Trust.
- f. To expand the funds of the Trust in such manner as they consider must be beneficial for the objects and purposes of the Trust.
- h. To acquire agricultural lands, build upon, pull down, rebuild, add to, alter repair, cultivate or improve, sell or dispose of any land, building or premises for the use of the Trust and to acquire other movables in tangible benefits of immovable properties to be acquired in future.
- i. To take any property on lease or hire in future.
- j. To let on hire or lease and transfer any movable or immovable properties not immediately required by the Trust to be acquired in future..
- k. To acquire any property in exchange for some other property or partly in such exchange and partly for other consideration(s) in future
- l. To borrow money upon the security of any of the property of the Trust on the terms and conditions that the trustees shall not borrow funds exceeding 75% of the market value of the assets of the Trust to be acquired in future.
- m. To make and from time to time repeal add or alter regulations.
  - i) As to the Management of the Trust and affairs thereof.
  - ii) As to conduct any of the matters of things will be under the control of the trustees provided the same shall not be inconsistent with the provisions contained in these presents.



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- n. To appoint, and remove managers, Secretary, clerks and other staff and workers required for the working for general management of the affairs of the Trust.

**15. BANKING ACCOUNTS:**

The Trust Board shall open one or more Bank accounts in the name of the Trust. All income of subscriptions and pecuniary donations for the general purposes of the Trust and the income from investments and all other money received from time to time forming part of the general revenue of the Trust shall be paid into one or more Banks.

The Trust Accounts should be maintained in the name of the Trust. The Bank Account will be opened by **The President And Any One Of The Persons Officially Named Secretary Or Treasurer Jointly** shall withdraw money.

**16. ACCOUNTS & AUDIT:**

The Accounting year of the Trust shall be from 1st April of 31st March every succeeding English Calendar year. The Founder and Trustees shall be responsible for maintaining proper books of Accounts with respect to.

- (i) all receipts and payments.
- (ii) Balance sheet
- (iii) all income and expenditure.
- (iv) Books of accounts and financial registers.
- (v) Receipt books, bills and vouchers.

A Chartered Accountant of a firm or Chartered Accountants shall audit the account of every year. The Board of Trustees shall appoint the C.A. or the firm every year (Explain to Section 288(2) and the Income Tax Act, 1961).

The Trust should have the necessary expertise and should maintain separate accounts in respect of the eligible project or schemes under the Income Tax Act 1961 section 35 AC, I & II.



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**17. VALUATION:**

The Founder and Trustees herein may maintain the list of properties acquired, administered and maintained by the Trust and the same shall always invest with the Trust.

**18. ADVISORY BOARD:**

The Founder and Trustees herein may maintain advisors for better administration of any particular objects engaging their services. The Trustees shall have liberty to fix remuneration for the services rendered by the Advisors.

**19. THE TRUST FUNDS:**

- a) Donations to be received.
- b) Donations to be received from any individual, public charitable institutions.
- c) Donation/assistance to be received from Government.
- d) Donation/assistance to be received from public.
- e) Gifts to be received from public and institutions.
- f) Voluntary contributions to be made with specific direction to form part of the corpus of the trust.
- g) Properties including deposits to be acquired in future.
- h) The Income to be derived from such property/ deposits .
- i) Foreign contributions/donations /gifts in the form of articles, currency all to be acquired in future whether India or foreign security, subject to the provisions of Foreign Contributions (Regulations) Act, 1956 and the Rules framed thereunder.

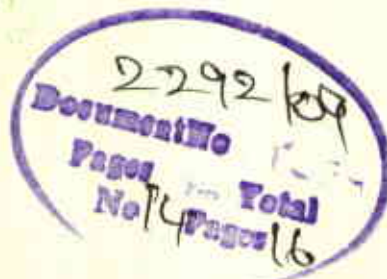
**20. GENERAL FUNCTION:**

1. This Trust is irrevocable. If the Trust hereby constituted fail for any reason in the opinion of the Founder Trustees of the Trust the net assets of the Trust both movable and immovable shall be hand over to any public charitable trust as decided by the majority of the trustees, which has similar objects.



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2. In the event of closure of winding up dissolution of the trust all its assets and liabilities, if any shall transferred to another Trust which has similar objects and enjoying Exemption which as registered under section 12A(a), 11 and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
3. The Exemption shall be forfeited on contravention of section-13 of income tax Act, 1961.
4. No part of the income of the trust shall be applied for the benefit of the president (or) Secretary (or) Treasurer, (or) persons who are substantially interested u/s 13(3).
5. The income of the Trust shall be applied for the purpose for which it is registered as per section 11(1) or 11(2) accumulated as per section.
6. The income and funds of the Trust shall be solely utilized towards the objects of the Trust and the income shall be utilized for Research Centre with prior approval of The Director of Income Tax (Exemptions) Under Section 80GGA Income Tax Act, 1961.
7. The Trust shall invest the investments as per Section 13(1)(d) read with Sec. 11(5) of the Income Tax. Act, 1961.
8. The Income and funds of the Trust shall be solely utilized towards the objects of the Trust and no portion of its income shall be utilized for salary to loan to Trustees by way of remuneration, profit, interest, dividends, etc., in Section 13(1)(c) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
9. Acquisition/alienation of immovable property shall be done with prior approval of the Director of Income Tax (Exemptions) in future.
10. Other than objects if any amendment to the instrument would be carried only with the approval of Director of Income Tax (Exemption).



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11. To sell, alienate, lease, mortgage, charge pledge, hypothecate, transfer of otherwise deal with all properties to be acquired in future funds and assets and any amendments to the Trust Deed / Memorandum of Association / Bye-laws will be carried out only with prior approval of Director of Income Tax Exemptions.
12. The Benefits of the objects would be available to the general public irrespective of caste, creed, religion or sex.
13. The Trust shall apply for exemption under Section 80-G in the prescribed form during the forecoming period.
14. The activities and functions of the Trust shall be utilized only towards charitable purpose and not for any profit motive.
15. Not more than 5% of the income of the trust/institution would be applied for any religious purposes or given to religious institutions. (any violation found will lead to denial of exemption under Sec. 80G considering the Trust as Public Religious in Nature).
16. Other than objects if any amendments to the instrument would be carried only with the approval of Director of Income Tax (Exemption).
17. At present the trust have no immovable property. **No activities of the Trust will be carried out anywhere outside India** the Trust should be confined within the territorial Jurisdiction of India, with prior permission from the appropriate/concerned authority of Director of Income Tax.

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
